

FAQs about the ILS

Q: When is class? How long is class?

A: The ILS has several different locations, days, and times for classes. Look at the listing of locations on the ILS page of this website.

Each class is 1 - 2 hours long.

Q: How much do I pay? When do I pay? Do you take cash, check, or credit card?

A: We ask for a \$35 donation each semester. Semesters are August – December, January – May, and June – July.

You will pay at your first class, and you will receive a receipt.

Pay in cash or check made out to *International Language School*. We cannot accept credit card payment.

Q: Can I attend class more than one time each week?

A: Yes. Talk to your teacher.

Q: What do you teach?

A: The different locations offer many types of instruction.

These include:

- Preparation for the Citizenship interview
- American conversation
- grammar, vocabulary pronunciation
- English through the Bible
- International Children's Choir
- professional services (resumes, applications, reports, etc.)
- academic services (reports, study skills, test-taking skills, etc.)

Q: Will we have class if there is bad weather?

A: If there is bad weather, call your teacher to find out if your class is meeting.

Q: Can someone pick me up for class and bring me home from class?

A: Check with a teacher at your location to find out if transportation is available.

Q: Can I bring my child(ren) to class?

A: Check with a teacher to find out if childcare is provided at your location. Normally, we ask that children not attend class because it is difficult for students to concentrate.

Q: What religion are you?

A: We are followers of Jesus Christ - Christians.

Q: If I am not a Christian, can I still attend class?

A: Yes, we are open to students of all faiths.
