

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) about the International Language School

Q: When are classes?

A: Beginning in August 2019, we will have regular ESL (English as a Second Language) classes two days/nights per week. You will choose one of the options below.
Monday and Wednesday classes, 6:30 p.m. - 8:30 p.m.
Tuesday and Thursday classes, 9:30 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.

Q: How long do classes meet?

A: Our ESL classes meet for two hours each day/night. This includes Tea Time and Reading Club. Our other classes meet for 1 ½ hours each week.

Q: How much do I pay? When do I pay? Do you take cash, check, or credit card?

A: We ask for a \$35 donation each semester (August – December, January – May) for ESL classes. This donation helps cover the costs of books and materials. You may also make 1 payment of \$70 for the entire school year. Other classes will be an additional \$35 per semester.

You may pay at registration or at your first class.

Pay in cash or check made out to *International Language School*. We cannot accept credit card payments at this time.

Q: Can I attend class more than one time each week?

A: Yes, our ESL classes meet two days or two nights per week. Our other classes meet once a week. You may attend ESL and another class if you want.

Q: Will we have class if there is bad weather?

A: If there is bad weather, call your teacher to find out if your class is meeting. We usually follow the Mobile County Public School System for cancellations due to bad weather.

Q: Can someone pick me up for class and take me home after class?

A: Ask a teacher if transportation is available.

Q: Can I bring my child(ren) to class?

A: Ask a teacher if childcare is provided. Normally, we ask that children not attend class because it is difficult for students to concentrate.

Q: What religion are you?

A: We are followers of Jesus Christ – Christians. We are part of the Mobile Baptist Association of the Southern Baptist Convention.

Q: If I am not a Christian, can I still attend class?

A: Of course. We are open to students of all faiths.
