Dear Co-laborers for Christ,

I am writing to you with a burdened heart. **OUR** camp is in a financial crisis. As of this letter we are set to run out of funds by **March 15, 2021**. Covid is continuing to cost us money through cancelled reservations. In spite of this we are continuing to receive requests to book the camp or attend our children's and youth summer camps. It is encouraging to know that there is still an interest in **OUR** camp. It is my conviction that God is not through ministering to people through **OUR** camp. I know that our Heavenly Father has the means to keep this camp open, even in the midst of a pandemic.

The key to continued ministry through CWP is **OUR** churches. As of today **only 12%** of the MBA churches have responded to the CWP relief fund. We are so incredibly grateful for the \$39,654.60 that those churches have given. Our calculations have shown that if EVERY member of EVERY church gave \$2.00 per person we could easily reach our goal of **\$112,000.00** to sustain the camp through the next year.

Please consider taking up a love offering for CWP. Every dollar we receive to the relief moves us closer to our goal of remaining open through summer, the time when we generate income for the rest of the year. A member of the camp committee will be contacting soon regarding the camp relief fund.
