

Walk For Bibles and International Ministries

Captain's Instructions

Posters

Place posters in highly visible locations where all ages will get the information. If you need more posters, contact the Mobile Baptist Association office at 251-661-7111.

Video

Use the 2019 Walk For Bibles and International Ministries DVD to announce and promote this years 5K walk. Plan to show the video in Sunday Worship, Sunday School classes, mission organizations, youth groups, and other meetings.

T-Shirts

WFBIM t-shirts can be purchased at the MBA office before the event for \$10, or the day of the walk for \$12, while supplies last.

Registration

Upon arrival all walkers must register at the WALKERS REGISTRATION TABLE and make a name tag. Walkers will also receive a walking map and an emergency contact number for any emergency needs.

Sponsor Sheet

There is a sponsor sheet in this packet. Use it as a "master" from which to copy all the sheets needed. Collect completed Sponsor Sheets and sponsorship money before the walk-date (October 19). Bring one church check for the total amount.

Team Report

The Team Report form should be completed by the Captain prior to arrival at the WALK. Only the Captain need come to the Captains Report Table (with the Team Report and collected money or checks payable to Walk for Bibles). Combine cash and change into large bills (no coins please). This really helps our accounting process.

Volunteers

Those who cannot walk may help with refreshments/water stations and other tasks. Please contact the Director of International Ministries, Bobby Morton, at 251-751-7441.

Prayer Station At the mid-way point, bottled water and a Prayer Guide for prayer walking will be distributed.

Transportation

Please transport your group in as few vehicles as possible. Once at the WFBIM site, follow parking crew member's directions.

Weather We will walk rain or shine so come prepared.

What to Bring

If desired bring personal water bottles and umbrella. Dress appropriately. Also, consider wearing your pre-ordered WFBIM t-shirts as a group.
