One of the main distinctives of Southern Baptists is our desire to cooperate together for missions. Southern Baptists have been doing missions through Associations since 1710 and through the *Cooperative Program* since 1925. In addition to the annual missions offerings for local, state, national, and foreign missions, cooperative giving is the main financial support for undergirding Southern Baptist mission work. Many churches choose to give a “tithe” of their income to missions by giving 7% to the Cooperative Program and 3% to the local Association.

INTERNATIONAL MINISTRIES CENTER (IMC)



Affectionately known as “the Seaman’s Center,” the IMC is a place for seafarers to hear the gospel. At the IMC sailors from all over the world

can receive a Bible, check e-mail, play basketball, receive a snack for the body and devotions for the soul. This is a Mobile Baptist Association ministry and is possible because of your faithful support.



INTERNATIONAL LANGUAGE SCHOOL (ILS)

The MBA works with churches to sponsor English as a Second Language (ESL) classes to help local internationals learn English and other languages. Every student has the opportunity to hear and learn about the gospel.

CHURCH PLANTING

One hundred and twelve MBA churches make up the Mobile Baptist Association (MBA). More than half of the county’s 410,000 people do not attend any evangelical church. We need new churches. New churches reach new pockets of people for Christ. Please pray and participate in new church starts as we attempt to touch every person in Mobile County with the Gospel.

METRO MOBILE BAPTIST CAMPUS MINISTRIES (MMBCM)

Your support helps us reach out to 14,000 USA students, more than 1,500 students at Spring Hill College, and 3,300 plus students at Bishop State Community College. The goal of MMBCM is to help MBA churches reach and train all students for a lifetime of effective ministry through every profession.



CHURCH DEVELOPMENT

The Church Development ministry helps churches grow inwardly and outwardly. Just a few of the areas of special training are: Men and Boys Ministries, Music and Worship, Sunday School, and Ministry to Women and Girls. More than 80 percent of MBA churches have participated in MBA sponsored trainings.

EVANGELISTIC MINISTRIES



The MBA coordinates evangelistic ministries throughout the year so that any size church can be a part of reaching greater Mobile County.

Some of the evangelistic training ministries include GPS (“God’s Plan for Sharing”), ERC (Evangelistic Response Center), and Party Trailer Outreach.

CAMP WHISPERING PINES (CWP)

Camp Whispering Pines is a camp/retreat space for church groups, and it offers conferences to help people grow in their relationships with Christ.
